**Our Parish St Vincent de Paul Conference:** thanks all who generously supported their *Retiring Collection* last week. Your support yielded the sum of £221.57. Also, somebody kindly contacted the SVP to offer furniture and household goods.

**One of our nearby neighbours** phoned the presbytery to point out that access to their house was blocked last Monday evening, 2<sup>nd</sup> November, when we had the evening Mass for the Catenians. Please **note** that our neighbours have a right to have access to their homes and they are quite right to complain if this is denied.

**Financial news:** In October the parish received £1,395.00 through your personal arrangements with banks. Many thanks again for your support and your planning for the upkeep of the parish. One person has kindly volunteered to join our parish support scheme through personal arrangements.

**The October 'head count':** the total of people attending Mass in Bakewell was 175 (in 2014 178). The total attending Mass in Hassop was 352 (397 last year). Our total at weekend Masses in both churches was 527 and it was 575 in 2014

**Retention of our local community transport** – there is a petition to sign to keep funding for this service at the back of our churches. If you have signed elsewhere or online there's no need to sign again.
