Last Wednesday morning we had our S V P meeting with 5 people present. We reviewed the pastoral visits and contacts made in recent weeks and thanks were expressed to S V P benefactors for their generous support – one donation of £250.00 and another for £70.00. Thank you!

Last Thursday evening we had a Liturgy Committee meeting and some very serious suggestions were made. Members of the committee are:- Tim Kilbride, Anne Shimwell, Alex Franji, Margaret Trend, Annemarie Jenkins, Juliet Peel, Lise Elliot, Fr Hugh and Christine Franklin joined us last Thursday. Serious suggestions about our Christmas services were discussed since a number of you did make some comments to some of the members about our Christmas services – and this is greatly welcomed. In the very near future, you will be asked about a radical overhaul of the services: for example, a children's carol service without Mass; a combined service on Christmas Eve at 6.30pm for children and adults – so no 9.00pm Christmas Mass; 2 Christmas morning Masses – one in Hassop and one in Bakewell; the children's service and the combined service to take place in Hassop not Bakewell. A lot to be considered and you will be asked for feedback.

Year of Mercy – Bishop Patrick has asked every deanery to hold a '24 hours for the Lord' prayer time over Friday 4th March to Saturday 5th March. He is personally going to visit many deaneries during Lent to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation with the People of God gathered in prayer. Lots of other events are happening in this *Year of Mercy* so don't be afraid to look out for things and respond to them.

Last Sunday morning in the parish rooms Sharon, Monica and Co. were talking about a new Crib: we have been talking about this for a few years in parish conversation. There was a Crib on offer – 75% discount – and Sharon thought it might be a good buy for the parish so we agreed to go ahead with its purchase.
