We now focus on 3 or 4 events in the year and hope you will be able to respond to these. We still need donations, bric-a-brac, good quality nearly new clothing, bottles galore for the tombola, cakes & preserves, jewellery and much more besides. Please ask Social Committee members about bringing your items to the presbytery because we have to keep the parish rooms in a reasonable state – especially after all the hard work put into cleaning them this past week.**Next Sunday** after Mass we have the 100 Club draw. We hope to build membership up to the 100 members mentioned in the title. At present we have about 82: two new members joined recently and we would like to have another 18 ... Forms for membership are available.**In April** parish support through personal banking arrangements was £1,890.00 – thank you for making the arrangements which include a number of annual contributions. As always, the parish is grateful to all who help to carry it along financially.
