July Diary (in part):

3rd July: ABC Carnival Service 11am on Bakewell Recreation Ground followed by fun, food and other events to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Association of Bakewell Christians, all welcome and we should try to support this event.

8th July at 7pm in Hassop church, our Ecumenical music evening with the joint choirs from our parish, Bakewell Parish Church and Bakewell Methodist communities along with visitors. This is organised by our own parish choir so, again, we are the host community and should support it. Refreshments provided after the music.
