Some of you might remember the young Polish priest called Fr Jerzy Popieleszko who was murdered in 1984 by State sponsored assassins. He was born in 1947 and only 37 when he was murdered during that difficult period of the SOLIDARITY movement in 1984. He was murdered on 19th October, savagely beaten and his body found on 30th October in freezing waters near to Wloclawek. Recently Fr Jerzy was beatified and his fidelity to the Gospel of Christ recognised in the Church. More than 500.000 people attended the funeral of this young priest.
