This & That: Last Thursday we had the Deanery meeting in Hassop. Many thanks to Tom & Monica for giving us a healthy 'working lunch'. We welcomed Fr Robbie O'Callaghan the new parish priest of Matlock. We also spoke about some pastoral concerns and **Living Stones** – remember that? Bishop Patrick has asked us to look at it again. Having been our Bishop for 16 months he now knows the Diocese a little better. **ALSO**, THE ADVENT penitential services were planned. Ours is on Sat. 17th December in Hassop at 11.00am. **YOU** have been told!

On Thursday evening, we had the AGM of the ~*Association of Bakewell Christians (ABC)* at which 2 represented our parish. The other church communities were well represented. We are not strong in ecumenical support. Ben Brown, Pastor Elim Church, has accepted to be the chairman for **ABC**. Our best wishes to Ben.

'Prisoners' Sunday' was remembered on 9th October. The Church is very involved in prison ministry and to the families that suffer because a family member is in prison. Did you know that *'Across England & Wales, an estimated 200,000 children are affected by a parent's imprisonment. The imprisonment of a family member can lead to school absences because (children) are taunted or bullied about a parent's imprisonment. Research shows that 41% of male offenders, 30% of female offenders and 52% of young offenders were permanently excluded from school.'* Did you know this? (cf *The Tablet* 8 October p 14).

October 'head count': Last weekend we had 41 people in Bakewell and 82 in Hassop – total =123. Last year we 30 in B/well and 126 in Hassop – total = 156.
