Safeguarding: The Church's policies about safeguarding say that anyone who has any ministry with children, young people or vulnerable adults should have some basic safeguarding training before or during the time they carry out that ministry. On **Wednesday, 10th May** between **7.00-9.00pm** John Creedon, the safeguarding coordinator for the Diocese, will be coming to All Saints Hassop to lead this training for our parish. Everyone in ministry with children or vulnerable adults in the parishes should make a special effort to attend this event

Safeguarding: The Catholic Church has made available seven e-learning modules free of charge to any member of the Catholic Community. Some of these would be useful for those who have a ministry with children or adults, covering child and adult safeguarding. One in particular, dealing with Child Exploitation and Online Safety, would be useful for any family with teenage children.
