Some action points were established: (1) Hassop's wall to be monitored and an estimate to be sought. (2) Bakewell's report will need further action through consultation with parishioners and Diocese. However, the feeling at the PPC was that the projected costs of bringing the building up to standard cannot be met by our parish community. Pastoral provision in Bakewell will be part of the ongoing discussions.
