There were nearly 30 people present and we were free to ask questions and think about the future. Fr Hugh informed the meeting of our recent questionnaire re the Bakewell church and a number of people asked to be kept informed about our plans. The *Sick & Retired Priests' Fund* (SRPF) was also mentioned. Our parish has contributed £25,240.00 since 2013: this is 75.94%. If you are giving privately to this fund, remember the parish is **not** credited with the amount. Better for us if you do it through the parish bank a/c with reference SRPF.

Our Bakewell questionnaire: This is the last weekend for your replies to be given. Thanks go to the people who have already responded: 24 replies received by way of the questionnaire and 2 by email. Of the 24 received per the questionnaire, 21 are not in favour of fund raising, 2 are and 1 would like to see Bakewell church kept open. There is positive feed-back re house Masses and a Mass centre.
