August is a quiet month for most of us, for some it might be considered a silly month, but whatever you are doing, wherever you are going, have a nice holiday.

Archbishop Teofilus Matulionis was beatified in Lithuania's capital Vilnius. He is widely regarded as a symbol of persecution. He spent 16 years in a labour camp because of his open devotion when Lithuania was practically ruled by the atheist soviet leaders. He was killed in 1962 by lethal injection on August 20, 1962, under soviet orders. A KGB police nurse most likely administered the injection after police beat Archbishop Matulionis in his apartment. We can all take an example from his devotion and though he didn't get to see it, thousands of people attended his beatification this June. Archbishop Matulionis, who was jailed and beaten for his faith throughout his life, dealt with his persecutors peacefully and instructed his followers to do the same. Cardinal Joachim Meisner who died on 5th July, aged 83, had attended the beatification in Vilnius before going on holiday, it was his last public appearance.
