**26<sup>th</sup> Next Sunday** is the Feast of Christ the Universal King and with this feast we bring a close the present Liturgical Year. In England & Wales the National Youth Day is celebrated and we have our last Sunday-of-month Mass for young parishioners. Please prepare as usual and many thanks to our organising parents, catechists and musicians.

**2018 First Communion meeting** takes place next Sunday with parents and the children who intend making their first Holy Communion after 10.00am Mass. Carol McDermott, Liz Marsh, Mickey Etchells and other volunteers will help the children to prepare for Reconciliation as well.

**Deanery Celebrations of Reconciliation:** All the parishes of Amber Valley Deanery will hold Reconciliation services during the holy season of Advent. Obviously **we are all** encouraged to live out the Sacraments of the Church in our personal lives – *not* just delegating this to other people to do for us! **Please** see in your own attitude a reflection of how you live your vocation in the Church remembering what the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vatican Council said, "*Every single one of us is called to holiness no matter what our duties are.*" There are different supports towards this holiness but some fruits of it have to be evident in our lives. He found a number of cracks in the marble due to corrosion and expansion of the cast iron rods holding it together for the last 200 years. However this corrosion may be active or it may have stabilised. It is likely he will recommend the cracks are sealed and monitored for movement over the next five years.
