**Our Parish Liturgy group** met on Thursday evening. Numbers were down a bit because of illness and other family commitments. That did not stop people from holding the meeting which finished at 9pm! We did a review of Advent and Christmas and again expressed our thanks to all who helped in the parish's celebrations. The 'new' style of Christmas Carol Service was looked at and we agreed that it did not go according to plan.

**Looking ahead:** Lent begins on 14<sup>th</sup> February with Ash Wednesday. There will be no Lent soups this year but we will continue with our Lent Jars. We are looking for a charity to help with our Lenten offerings: if you have any suggestions, please let Juliet or Fr Hugh know about it. We will continue with the short form of the Way of the Cross on Fridays just after the 11.30am Mass. Parishioners who would like to make the Way of the Cross at another time, please feel free to do this and organise it for Friday evenings if this is your preferred time.

**Some parishioners** will be approached to consider becoming Eucharistic Ministers: we are now reaching a critical stage in this ministry. Other ministries of service will be suggested to **you** as the parish community. Again, we are most grateful to all who help and are so committed.

**As we journey through Lent** we will have First Reconciliation for the young parishioners making their First Holy Communion this year (Planned for 17<sup>th</sup> March). We are planning the usual parish Reconciliation service for 24<sup>th</sup> March and a special family Reconciliation service for 31<sup>st</sup>.

**At Easter** we have the reception of Yvette into the family of the Church: Yvette is already baptised and so her reception will be the Profession of Faith, reception of the Eucharist and Reconciliation. Her Confirmation will take place with the others we have later in the year.

**Looking towards the Eucharistic Congress** that will take place next September (7 – 9<sup>th</sup>) in Liverpool. The Congress takes place over the weekend and we are still hoping to have representatives there. Expenses for this would be a parish expense. The organisers need to know how many will be coming from every parish in England! Part of this is security reasons but there are also catering and event planning that have to be prepared.

**Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> March** we have a special gathering at Cliff College in Baslow to look at the future of **Association of Bakewell Christians** (usually referred to as **ABC**). It is planned to have the meeting from 10am to 3pm and lunch will be provided along with other refreshments. Each church community will help with the finances of this meeting since the local clergy are keen to keep **ABC** alive and well with, perhaps, a different and updated focus. The meeting is open to all who would like to attend or who might even want to see Cliff College close up!
