From our last PPC meeting: Following on Fr Paul Chipchase's visit and recommendation that the PPC organise a parish open meeting to consider the question of two churches, a meeting was planned for Sunday. As Fr Chipchase can't do this time a new one has to be arranged.

Last Sunday in Hassop: those gathered at Mass will know that the Mass was disrupted as we came to its end because of poor parking on the lane.
