There are little souvenir cards commemorating the anniversary available for our ministers.

Also last Saturday we had our Summer Barbecue with the proceeds going to support the Holy Ghost Fathers sick & aged members. It was a lovely evening; it was well supported and the atmosphere was very nice. Apparently, there were a few hiccups so apologies for these if the evening didn't unfold as well as we thought it would. The final amount to be forwarded to the Holy Ghost Fathers is £900.00 which is an excellent result.

Diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place next month, 16 – 20th July. It is a shorter period (between weekends) and it is not too late to book a place.
