**News from Lourdes:** 259 pilgrims here with Bishop Patrick, this includes 120 young people who help the less mobile pilgrims. The international Mass on Wednesday morning had 13 bishops, about 250 concelebrants and upwards of 4000 people. On Tuesday evening we had the Reconciliation service with 18 confessors. The service began at 8.30pm and Confessions finished about 11.00pm - a bit different from our own parish services. Lourdes certainly gives a "lift" to a pilgrim sojourner and this year the security arrangements are not as tight as they have been in recent years.
