This is not only for Safeguarding purposes, but also Data Protection. As a parish we need to ensure that we have parents' consent for each and every photo taken if it is going to be displayed, any commentary on the display to focus on the activity rather than the individual, appropriate dress is worn, be general in labelling photographs e.g. Communion Group 2013 rather than naming each child and be clear as to the purposes and storage of the photos. Photos taken should only be used for the purpose for which they were taken. Consent forms are available in the Parish Rooms.'* It won't be easy to handle this especially when "we" are moved by the spirit of the moment!
