Refreshments available after 10.00am Mass in parish rooms – visitors very welcome to join us and we'll have the 100 Club draw. New members needed to restore us to 100 members of the club.

**15<sup>th</sup> Home Communion** visits plus Meeting with Parish Catechists (afternoon)

**22<sup>nd</sup>** St Vincent de Paul Society meeting after Bakewell Mass. New members are urgently needed if it is to survive. If you have a bit of time and a bit of concern for others, come along and meet our SVP members.

**19-20<sup>th</sup>** (Next weekend) Diocesan collection for *Sick & Retired Priests Fund*. This is one of the obligatory 2<sup>nd</sup> collections and we have it every January.

**27<sup>th</sup>** Last Sunday of month – our Family Mass. Please help Sarah and Christine to prepare for this celebration. At last meeting of the Liturgy Committee, we agreed to give the emphasis towards a family Mass rather than one for young parishioners. Hopefully, this will lead to more involvement.

**27<sup>th</sup>** After Mass, a short meeting of counters in sacristy to look at the Diocesan guidelines re parish counters.

**Altar Servers:** Rachel Wilson has kindly agreed to organise & train new servers but Rachel will need the support of parents in the parish. Please be generous in responding. At present we have only two regular servers who help at the weekend Masses. Ideally we need 6 – 8 so that there can be a rota as we have for other ministries. Luckily we still have willing helpers when there are no servers but there should always be a server present – it is a service to the parish community.

**Last Sunday morning in Bakewell** Marie had a very unfortunate fall down the steps of the church. Very fortunately there were no major injuries apparent but Marie was taken to hospital from the church and discharged on the Sunday night about 10.00pm. Marie has sent a message to thank all the people who remained behind with her whilst the paramedic and the ambulance staff made her comfortable and prepared her for hospital. The whole operation took about 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>hrs and it was a cold morning! Parishioners stayed with her and helped to keep her warm by providing a blanket, a pillow and overcoat.

**First Reconciliation + Communion 2019:** there are plans afoot to prepare our younger parishioners for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion and these will be discussed at Catechists' meeting on Tuesday.

**From the Parish Finance Committee:** a meeting was held on Wed. evening-all members were present. The Diocesan Finance Office + the Property Office are both in regular correspondence about our Bakewell church. At present the parish is paying **£877.00 per month** as its monthly quota. This figure is based on a time when we had an exceptional amount of money paid directly to the Finance Office because of arrangements made at the time of Hassop's new heating system. The Diocesan admin. has pegged our quota to the Gift Aid claimed in that year. A letter will be sent to the Finance Office seeking clarification about what is seen as an excessive amount.
