Next Sunday 3rd March we have the final Mass in English Martyrs Church Bakewell at 10.00am. Sadly for us, the church will close for worship because of the condition of the building and the requirements of the 2016 Quinquennial Report that the Diocese commissioned. As a parish community we've prepared for this day through the consultation (33 people saying no to fundraising & 3 in favour of this), the Open Meeting last September and the final parish meeting on 11th February, just a few weeks ago

After the final Mass in Bakewell parish arrangements will be these:- we shall have two weekend Masses, one on Saturday evenings at **6.00pm** (note new time) and one on Sunday mornings **10.00am**. We are still negotiating with the Methodist Church in Bakewell for use of their chapel for our Saturday evening Masses. By next weekend we should know whether or not we can move immediately to their chapel or not. If we can't, we'll have the Masses in Hassop.

Weekday Masses in Bakewell will be celebrated as house Masses. A group of volunteers has already said that we can try this method experimentally. The first house Mass will be celebrated at **10.00am** at Peter & Juliet Peel's house.
