**Next Saturday (9<sup>th</sup> March)** the Vigil Mass in Bakewell will be celebrated in the METHODIST CHURCH at 6.00pm. We are very grateful to the Methodist minister (Rev. Adrian Perry) and his PPC for facilitating our request to accommodate us on Saturday evenings. This is a temporary arrangement until further formalities are completed so we have to be on our best behaviour remembering we are guests in another community. So, for the future, there will be no "switch-over" on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of the month and all evening Masses will be celebrated at 6.00pm unless otherwise announced. There are no steps at the Methodist church and there is some car parking but the public car parks are nearby so it should be easier for us.

Donations from this will be added to our Lent Jars which are now available. We are exploring the possibility of helping a local charity which helps young people. We will also continue to have a time of Adoration and a short meditation on the Way of the Cross. Some parishioners may wish to have an evening meditation on the Way of the Cross – please feel free to arrange this. The Parish Church in Bakewell will have the Stations of the Cross on Monday evenings at 7.00pm. There may be other Lent activities that individuals join in; please let us know about them.

**Weekly Envelops and Gift Aid:** regular parishioners and visitors will know our 'systems' for financial support of the parish. We have a core group that is very regular and supportive of parish needs and take this responsibility very seriously. Thank you all very much.
