Friday soups in Lent are continuing: so far, they have gone well but we still need volunteers to prepare the soups.

Parish Transport rota existed in the past and it looks like it would be a good idea to have one once more. If you would like to help somebody to get to Mass, please let Fr Hugh know for the time being. However, we'll be looking for a co-ordinator to keep it all together.

For the next Family Mass (on 31st March) we'll be having a new Eucharistic Prayer: it is already prepared thanks to Christine & Juliet and will be slightly different to the one we've been having. There are several Eucharistic Prayers and, if you have a favourite one, please ask for it to be said by the celebrant ... but please give plenty of notice for this!

From the Diocese: there is now a formal statement saying that English Martyrs Church has closed and a notice to this effect has to be displayed on the church in Bakewell. Also, as we prepare for the future of our parishes, it is foreseen that there may only be three priests and two deacons in Amber Valley Deanery by 2021. The Mass times are constantly being revised as needs demand and another consequence will be that catering for non-parishioners will be very difficult especially weddings and funerals. Bishop Patrick will be approached about commissioning lay ministers for some parish ministries. For us, we are still looking for "missionary disciples" to become Eucharistic Ministers in the parish community.
