From Thursday's Liturgy meeting: We still struggle to have regular servers and this should be faced up to by our parish community. Other Readers and Eucharistic Ministers are still needed: Anne Shimwell keeps things together in this little corner. On questions of ecumenism, some members felt that we are now a little bit out of touch with the other church communities since the closure of our Bakewell church. The suggestion was made that somebody take this ecumenical outreach as a parish portfolio. It was also suggested that we have a parishioner or a regular visitor to have a *Justice & Peace* portfolio.
