**Next Saturday evening** there is a "Knees Up" as part of the parish weekend in Belper. Fr Michael Kirkham and parishioners are preparing the parish for this weekend of "Welcome" to all who would like to join in.

**Red Boxes** are being prepared for APF and Mill Hill Missionaries. Also available is their magazine "Mission Today". The Pope's prayer intention for July is:- *May those who administer justice work with integrity, and may the injustice present in the world not have the last word.* This magazine tells us that there are 3,086,289 catechists working with young people on their faith journey.

**Parish Directory:** we will try to update this during the summer with the help of Tory Paxman. Because of data protection rules, we will probably have to ask your permission to have your names recorded in the directory.

**In September** we are going ahead with the idea to have a Pastoral Assistant in the parish. It will be a part time post and salaried. This will require us to look at parish finances as plans unfold and it is a preparation for the time when there may be no resident priest in the parish.

**14<sup>th</sup> July Padley Pilgrimage:** this is our local pilgrimage and begins at 3.00pm by gathering at Grindelford Station. It follows the usual structure with the recitation of the Rosary and afternoon Mass presided over by the Bishop of Hallam. We can, of course, receive Holy Communion at this pilgrimage Mass. The diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes leaves on the same day and returns the following weekend.

**We haven't done it yet** but we must keep in mind the recommissioning of our parish Eucharistic Ministers before too long. Usually we have done this in both churches but this year we will do it only in Hassop.
