**3<sup>rd</sup>** (Next Saturday) Blessing of headstone for Rebecca Wiles at 4.00pm in the parish cemetery with Rebecca's parents and family members. Some of you may remember Rebecca who died as a young child many years ago and her family now wishes to remember her short life and presence in their lives by this blessing. They will join us for Sunday Mass next week.

**6<sup>th</sup>** Final preparations for Parish Directory

**15<sup>th</sup>** Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady – two Masses on the day at 10.00am and 6.00pm both in Hassop. The Assumption remains a holy day for us hence the provision of two Masses. Recently, in another diocese, parishioners in a large urban parish, who wished to attend Mass on a holy day of obligation, were offered only one Mass in the evening. For a convenient Mass some people had to travel 8 miles or even more. We are still fortunate in our parish!

**New Pastoral Assistant** will be appointed at the beginning of September: we are just waiting for the Diocese to give some final guidelines since the post will be salaried. It is not full time but it is an effort to plan for the possibility when we do not have a resident priest in Hassop. Later in August there will be an interview with the person who has expressed interest in the post.

**The "last call" for the 2019 parish directory** was made last weekend. Many thanks to all who gave permission to print their details in the directory. It has been pointed out several times how helpful this little tool is especially for those who plan ministries or need to contact parishioners at short notice. In a few weeks we'll have the draft document available for corrections and approval. Fifty parishioners or regular visitors have so far completed directory forms. If you are not included, it is because you have chosen not to be included. However, if you need information about parishioners, you cannot call the parish office for this.

**Eucharistic Ministers:** in recent years we have been asking for parishioners to consider accepting the service of being a Eucharistic Minister. This year one parishioner, Sarah Carter, has agreed to attend the training course

**Recent Gift Aid repayments:** the parish a/c has received £1,619.50 from Lise's recent submission to HMRC. **Bishop John Wilson** (Auxiliary Bishop in Westminster Archdiocese) has been appointed the new Archbishop of Southwark and has already taken up his post.

**On 14<sup>th</sup> September** Fr Hugh celebrates 50 years of ordination. It is a Saturday (in 1969 it was a Sunday)! There will be Mass at 11.00am in Hassop and it is the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. It will be simple and will be an "extra" Mass thus **not** replacing weekend Masses. As we move towards the date, more information will be given.
