Sarah Carter who prepares the liturgies for our Family Masses has very kindly agreed to serve the parish community as a part time Pastoral Assistant. We were able to finalise the arrangements on Wednesday morning when we had a friendly and informal meeting with Sarah. There will be a contract with Nottingham Diocese but the parish will pay Sarah's monthly salary. Sarah begins her new role on 3rd September and comes to us with a background in MSc studies and experience in environmental concerns along with administration skills. Sarah, like all newcomers to parish life, comes as a "novice" with much to learn about how we keep things together – diary, registers, "filling the gap" when something doesn't happen and lots more besides. She will work on Weds & Friday mornings initially with a review planned for later in the year.

What is a Pastoral Assistant? Most parishes these days have a back-up staff because of (a) a new understanding of ministry in the Church and (b) we no longer have the clergy to do all the tasks involved in parish life. These have greatly increased because of Safeguarding, Health & Safety and lots more besides. The emphasis in our case is on the word pastoral so that the assistant can help in the many areas that require some help and attention. So, the P.A. is not a secretary, not a cook, not a sacristan, not a parish driver, not a counter of Sunday collections **BUT** probably has to do a bit of all these jobs at one stage or another. That is pastoral/parish life in today's Church!

Bishop Patrick McKinney would like every parish to be represented at some important diocesan meetings which are:- 2nd October at Mackworth (Fr Hugh + two 'volunteers' from Wednesday's Mass), 12th Oct. parish administrators' roles in parish life, 17th Oct. Safeguarding (Fr H & A H). For our parish, the AGM is on 20th Oct. with the new suggestion to replace the PPC. Busy days ahead for those who hear.
