Parish Head Count: Total attendance at Mass for the 4 weeks between 21st Sept and 12th Oct were as follows (totals for 2018 given in brackets): Bakewell - 97 adults, no children (183), Hassop - 281 adults and 40 children (288).

ASVG: The ASVG is appealing for good, clean clothing for young women, men and children in support of the Bakewell Area Asylum Seekers and Refugees Programme. Items may be brought to the Parish Rooms on 27th October or 3rd November for sorting and delivery by the ASVG members.

Diocesan Administrators Day: Four members of the parish attended a training day in Nottingham last Saturday. Issues of finance administration and gift aid, data protection and health and safety were covered. A few points were raised that may affect the way we need to do things in order to comply with guidelines, but we can adapt them to suit our small parish.

Council of Priests met last Monday and Fr Hugh attended to present the petition for the closure of our Bakewell church: this petition was voted on and about 19 of the priests present, including Bishop Patrick, voted in favour of the petition. This is another step required in the Canon Law process.

Christmas Fair: The Christmas Fair takes place on 30th November and so preparations are underway. As always the Social Committee do a wonderful job in making things happen but help is always needed. Raffle tickets are available in Hassop. Last Sunday one kind soul took tickets from the church, carried them to the parish rooms and then left them there forgetting about them. Now that will help the Christmas Fair, won't it??? Cash prizes, good items, cakes and preserves, etc., will all be needed. Ask Peter & Sharon for guidance if you need it. It's time to get ready.
