Next Sunday is The Feast of Christ The King and is National Youth Sunday:

On Sunday 24th November, the Church in England and Wales celebrates National Youth Sunday. On this day, we celebrate the young people in our parish and community and all the gifts and talents they share with us. The theme for this year's NYS is taken from Christus Vivit, Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation to young people: "For him, you have worth; you are not insignificant. You are important to him, for you are the work of his hands. That is why he is concerned about you and looks to you with affection." (Christus Vivit, 115). **We hope all our young people will join us to celebrate on this special day.**

Deanery Meeting: At Thursday's Deanery meeting, the clergy present spent time in Adoration and prayer. Afterwards we came up with various suggestions about the "*The God who Speaks*" which begins on the 1st Sunday of Advent and will be celebrated throughout the whole Church. We have copies of St Matthew's gospel available as this will be the gospel we will mostly use in Year C.

Advent Reconciliation Service: Our Advent Reconciliation Service will take place on 14th December beginning at 11.00am.

Plans for Christmas: Our first Mass for the celebration of Christmas will be a Family Mass on Christmas Eve at 5.30 pm. This Mass is especially for the children of our parish and we expect the church to be quite full. We would encourage our other parishioners, if they are able, to attend the other Masses for Christmas, either 9.30 pm on Christmas Eve or 10 am on Christmas morning. All Masses will be in Hassop.

ASVG: Thank you to all who responded so generously to our recent appeal for clothing in support of the Bakewell Asylum Seeker and Refugee Programme. We are so grateful for your wonderful support.

On Saturday 16th November Fr Hugh plus Sarah and family members attended her Commissioning in the Cathedral as an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Eucharist. Sarah attended the training course and we are very grateful to her for accepting this service in our parish community.

Our Bakewell Church: Bishop Patrick has written to the parish to inform us that English Martyrs Church Bakewell is now Canonically closed and ceases to be a church within the Diocese. There are certain responsibilities about how the church is disposed of and the Diocese will be pro-active in this matter.

Advent Group: - There is a York Course entitled 'Who are we praying to?' It is a 4 week course and if anyone would be interested in meeting one afternoon or evening a week in Advent please speak to Juliet Peel or a member of the Liturgy group.

Christmas Tree Festival in the Bakewell Parish: The Opening Service 7pm Thursday 12th Dec, Taize Service 6pm Sunday 15th Dec and The Community Carol Service and Closing Service 6pm 22nd Dec. Also taking place in Bakewell is The Town Nativity 2pm Saturday 21st Dec ending with the Blessing of the Crib in Bath Gardens at 3.15pm. All are welcome.

St Ralph Sherwin Catholic Multi Academy Trust: This diocesan organisation is responsible for overseeing Chaplaincy support in 25 schools in the Trust and although we do not have a school affiliated to our parish we are included in their activities. There will be a celebration of Mass in The Winding Wheel in Chesterfield on Monday 2nd December to celebrate the Feast of St Ralph Sherwin.
