Following his recent tour of Thailand and Japan, Pope Francis addressed pilgrims in St Peter's Square, telling them that this visit had increased his closeness and affection for the peoples there. In particular, the Pope noted the celebration of Mass in a hospital, commenting that "we saw clearly how the Gospel is being inculturated among the Thai people." In Japan, Pope Francis highlighted the motto for the visit, which was "Protect All Life". "To protect life one must love it", he said, "and today the serious threat, in more developed countries, is the loss of a sense of living". The Pope went on to say, that the first victims of this are young people, that is why, he said, he encouraged them to face the future without fear by opening their hearts to God's love in prayer and in service of others. He recalled his appeal for the abolition of nuclear weapons. Pope Francis praised Japan for "remaining faithful to its religious and moral values, and open to the Gospel message, adding, that it can be a leading country for a more just and peaceful world.
