The first day of the new year, 1 January 2020, was the Feast of Mary, Mother of God. It was also the **53rd World Day of Peace**. Pope Francis' latest World Day of Peace message was entitled '**Peace as a Journey of Hope: Dialogue, Reconciliation and Ecological Conversion**'. Hope was again at the heart of Pope Francis message, which opened with the statement: "Peace is a great and precious value, the object of our hope and the aspiration of the entire human family".

Hope, writes the Pope, is "the virtue that inspires us and keeps us moving forward, even when obstacles seem insurmountable". "Peace will not be obtained unless it is hoped for". Pope Francis also refers to the recent Synod on the Pan-Amazon Region. "Faced with the consequences of our hostility towards others, our lack of respect for our common home or our abusive exploitation of natural resources, we are in need of an ecological conversion", he writes, one that will "lead us to a new way of looking at life". The Pope concludes with a renewed call "for a peaceful relationship between communities and the land, between present and past, between experience...and hope".

Next Sunday, second Sunday, we have the Children's Liturgy; children are welcome to join the catechists in the parish rooms after the opening hymn until the offertory.
