Parish Open Meeting took place last Wednesday: this replaces the traditional PPC. Thanks to the people who came along on a nasty evening and to Bill McDermott for chairing the meeting – twelve generous souls made it worthwhile and a few offered their apologies. Progress reports were given re plans for the back of the presbytery space (Bill McD.) and the stone work to be done on the exterior of the church (Tony M.) Also, parishioners present asked about the cemetery, the state of the lane where the church is and the new sound/vision plans for the parish rooms. The important thing to remember is that we have a pastoral vision towards the future when there may not be a resident priest in Hassop and that plan was re-iterated. The next 'parish open meeting' is on Sunday 19th July after Mass.

Ash Wednesday: 26th February - we have morning Mass at 10.00am and evening Mass at 6.00pm. It is observed by fasting and abstinence. Lent Jars will be available to support our Lent charities including *Cavendish Cancer Care*. Parish Lent Jars are available to take home and the proceeds help our Lent charities.

Lent Soups: Don't forget that after Mass and the short Way of the Cross on Fridays we gather for a simple lunch, with donations going towards our Lent charities. The short Way of the Cross and Lent soups begin **this coming Friday** (28th Feb.)
