Fr Bernard Needham gave a very interesting talk on the first books of the Bible. Thank you for coming and we hope you will come again next Wednesday. If you couldn't come last week, do feel free to come along for the next one and the ones that follow. **Next Wednesday, 11th** Fr Gerry Murphy (Buxton) will speak about the next segment of the Bible viz. the Historical Books at 2pm. Please join us for this hour of informal discussion and reflection. Fr Gerry has asked that we bring our bibles along, and as way of preparation for the session he suggests that we take a look at the Book of Ruth.**Interest in our Church:** Last Monday Elena Curti visited as she is writing a book on historic churches and came to view the church and take some photos. Her visit gave her an insight into the many challenges we face maintaining a grade 1 listed church.
