Last Tuesday was the 40th anniversary of the assassination of Archbishop Oscar Romero: he was killed by a death squad whilst celebrating Mass in El Salvador. He was a staunch supporter of the rights of the poor and the unjustly treated in society. He was declared a saint in October 2018.
